

New U9 Format beginning fall of 2018!

New this season is the introduction of Fundamentals 1 & Fundamentals 2 to the U9 Ringette program. These will be introductory programs for players new to the game or players who have limited experience with Ringette. Players are typically under 10 years of age in these divisions. Players playing in the fundamental divisions will have the opportunity to learn and develop their Ringette skills in a program that offers a 1-2 ice times per week. Players in the Fundamental divisions will learn the game through game play on cross ice or half ice surfaces and modified or mini games. Many of the games will take place at jamboree opportunities and participants will see a limited travel schedule as they will primarily play inter-association and neighbouring association games.

The purpose of the Fundamentals 1 & Fundamentals 2 program is to offer players the opportunity to learn the game of Ringette and develop strong skating skills in a fun, active, engaging environment. The cross ice and half ice programs allow kids to focus on the skill development required for the game in an environment that allows for lots of success, fun and maximum participation for all players.

Players will attend practices and skates at the beginning of the season to determine which division is the best fit for them.
